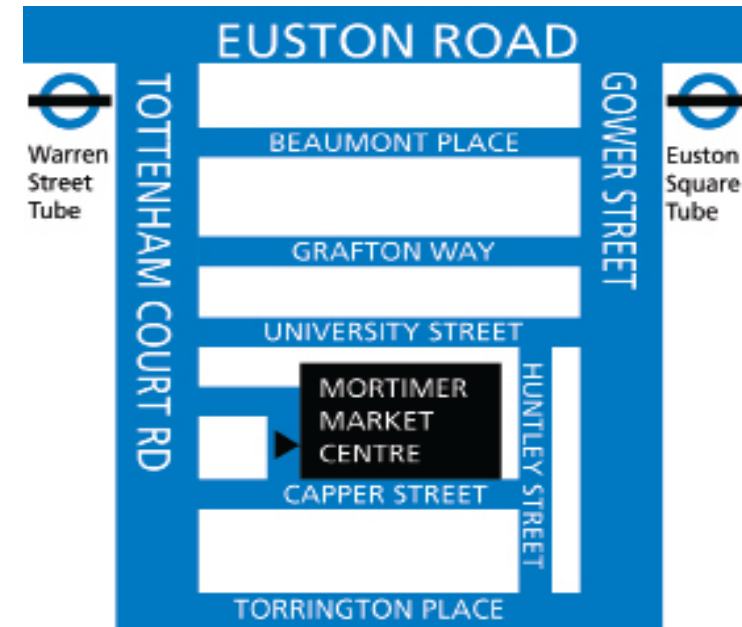

About Mortimer Market Centre

We provide a range of sexual health services, free of charge. Services are open access, which means that you do not have to be referred by your GP.

Services include:

- screening and treatment for a wide variety of STIs including Chlamydia & Gonorrhoea
- rapid HIV testing
- Hepatitis A & B vaccination
- free condoms and lube
- emergency contraception
- support, information following sexual assault
- advice and counselling on sexual health issues
- referral to Clinical Psychology for sexual health related issues.

HIV care & treatment

Booking your visit

All clinics are by appointment only. Please allow 2 hours for your visit.

To make an appointment call:

We will ask you for your name and contact telephone number. You can use a different name if you wish, but please remember the details you use to ensure you receive the correct results. You may wish to book an appointment:

- as part of a sexual health check up
- if you are thinking about not using condoms in a relationship
- if you are concerned about sexual or other risks taken
- if a current or previous partner is HIV positive
- if you think you might be HIV positive and wish to confirm this and discuss treatment options.

Before your visit

Please do not pass urine for 1 hour before your appointment.

During your visit

A nurse or doctor will ask some questions about your sexual and medical history.

You may then be examined before being tested for various infections. Routine tests include swabs for sexually transmitted infections and a blood test for syphilis.

We recommend a rapid HIV test. Knowing your HIV status will allow you to make informed choices about your physical, emotional and sexual wellbeing. Blood tests for Hepatitis (A, B, C) are only carried out where indicated.

Many people have no symptoms and no obvious sign of infection at their first visit but are still found to have conditions that need treatment.

Please note that Mortimer Market Centre is part of a teaching hospital and a medical student may be present.

Your test results

After your tests are completed, you may be asked to wait until your preliminary results are ready, usually within 30 minutes. Where appropriate, we may offer you immediate treatment.

Full results take 7-10 days and we will either write to you or call you with your results. Some patients may be asked to return to the clinic to collect results or receive further treatment.

If you fail to keep your results appointment and you have an infection, we will need to contact you by letter or phone.
