New integrated sexual and reproductive health centre opens in Islington

The Archway Centre, a new integrated sexual and reproductive health service, opens in Islington on Tuesday 29 June. NHS Camden Provider Services' has spent almost a year refurbishing a snooker hall and laser-quest game arcade on a former brownfield site in the heart of Archway. Black walls and graffiti-art have been replaced with stylish interiors and sustainable features such as energy-efficient sun pipes. Visitors will benefit from touch-screen self-registration services, a children's play-area and a buggy store.

Contraceptive and sexual health services previously located nearby in The Northern Health Centre and Archway Sexual Health Clinic can now be accessed in this single convenient location. More than 30,000 patients are expected to attend The Archway Centre over the next year for a wide range of tests and treatments including rapid HIV testing and cervical smears.

Located within minutes of Archway tube station (Northern line) and Upper Holloway overground station the centre is easily accessible and on many bus routes.
