



About The Archway Centre

We provide free sexual health and contraceptive services. All clinics are by appointment only. See reverse for more details.

Services include:

- testing and treatment for sexually transmitted infections for men and women
- emergency contraception
- contraception including implants and IUDs
- pregnancy testing
- referral for abortion
- rapid HIV testing
- free condoms and lube
- Hepatitis B screening and vaccination
- post exposure prophylaxis for sexual exposure to HIV (PEPSE)
- information and advice on sexual health for men and women
- cervical screening (smear test)
- pre-pregnancy advice
- advice on women's health issues
- specialist psychological support relating to sexual health
- support information and onward referral following sexual assault
- easy non-invasive testing for chlamydia and gonorrhoea

During your visit

- we have female and male specialist health care professionals
- a nurse or doctor will ask some questions about your sexual or contraceptive history and a clinical examination may be required
- if you need an interpreter during your appointment, please let us know when you book your appointment. We require one week's notice to book an interpreter

- please note that The Archway Centre is a teaching clinic which means that medical or nursing students may be present during your appointment

Test results

Results generally take 7 to 10 days (smear test results up to 4 weeks). Same day results are available for a limited number of tests. We will text, call or write to you with your results. Some patients may be asked to return to the clinic to receive further treatment.


Young person's walk-in service
